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## Marking the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary: DFW Business Group on Health Announces Fall 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades for North Texas

**Dallas, TX November 16, 2022** –Marking the tenth anniversary of the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade, **DFW Business Group on Health**, a non-profit coalition of DFW area employers and The Leapfrog Group, an independent national watchdog organization representing hundreds of the nation’s most influential employers and purchasers of health care, co-announced the release of the [fall 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades](#) for **North Texas**.

The Leapfrog Group has a 10-year history of assigning letter grades to general hospitals throughout the United States, based on a hospital’s ability to prevent medical errors and harm to patients. The grading system is peer-reviewed, fully transparent, and free to the public. Hospital Safety Grade results are based on more than 30 national performance measures and are updated each fall and spring. **DFW Business Group on Health** is the [Regional Leader](#) for The Leapfrog Group in the North Texas region.

In **North Texas** (Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Erath, Grayson, Henderson, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Palo Pinto, Parker, Rockwall, Somervell, Tarrant and Wise counties), 60 hospitals were graded: 18 earned an “A,” 14 earned a “B,” 24 scored a “C,” 3 obtained a “D,” and 1 received an “F.” Texas moved up to the 14<sup>th</sup> spot in the Fall U.S. rankings, compared to 22<sup>nd</sup> in the Spring 2022 rankings.
